

Job Title: Technical Director of Soccer and Futsal

Location: Nexus Futbol Academy

Job Overview:

As the Technical Director, you will be responsible for overseeing the coaching of the Nexus Futbol Program, including soccer, futsal, and all the components of our program to develop our student-athletes. It will include the development and implementation of coaching curriculum, mentorship of coaching staff, enhancement of player development programs, and communication with Nexus parents. Your leadership will be instrumental in fostering a positive, competitive, and educational environment for all students and coaches.

Key Responsibilities

- **Soccer and Futsal Coaching Program Development:** Design, implement, and regularly update a comprehensive coaching education program that aligns with our philosophy and objectives. Ensure programs are in line with our philosophy and culture.
- **Staff Management:** Recruit, train, and mentor coaching staff. Conduct weekly performance evaluations and provide constructive feedback to ensure high-quality coaching. Host at least 5 coaches team building meetings per year, 3 coaches soccer training sessions per year, and 3 coaches futsal training sessions per year.
- **Professional Development:** Promote continuous learning and professional development among the coaching staff through workshops, certifications, and seminars. Evaluate coaches at least once per year
- **Compliance and Standards:** Ensure that all coaching practices meet Nexus standards. Ensure all coaches, players, and parents maintain standards set by Nexus, policies, and procedures. Enforce policies and procedures in accordance with Nexus and Heart and Sole Bylaws and Policies.
- **Player Development:** Oversee player development programs from the elementary through high school students, including player assessments and



- individual development plans. Ensure coaches submit assessments twice in a school year.
- **Parent Communication**: meet with parents to review player development process and objectives.
- Reporting/Communicating to Head of Futbol: work with our Head of Futbol to review, update, and implement coaching methodologies, development processes, and development components.
- **Community Engagement:** Represent the Nexus brand in the community, fostering relationships that benefit the school and its members. Maintain a positive connection with parents, local clubs, and the community in general.
- **Equipment Management:** Oversee equipment distribution and purchases. Work with the Head of Soccer and General Manager to maintain and meet budget requirements. Maintain and update Nexus and Heart and Sole equipment inventory.
- **Tournament Planning:** Coordinate and oversee the participation of Nexus students in local and out state tournaments. Organize at least one local Futsal tournament every year.

Qualifications:

- Minimum of 5 years of proven experience in coaching and sports program management.
- Strong leadership, communication, and organizational skills.
- Ability to work collaboratively with staff, students, and community members.
- Knowledge of current coaching methodologies, player development models, and soccer trends.
- Availability to work evenings, weekends, and travel as required.
